



COVID protocols in place for the start the 22-23 school year

Stay Home If You Are Sick

It is important that students & staff stay home if exhibiting any combination of COVID-19 symptoms.

- COVID-19 symptoms are:
 - Fever or chills
 - Cough
 - Runny Nose or congestion
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea

Students exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms at school will be sent home.

- If symptoms clear within 48 hours students and staff can return to school. If the symptoms persist for longer than 48 hours, proof of a COVID test will be required to return to school.

If a staff member or student tests positive for COVID-19:

- Isolate at home for 5 days.
 - If, on day 5, symptoms are improving and they have been fever-free without using medication for at least 24 hours, they can return to school on the 6th day.
 - **A mask must be worn from day 6-10** at school.
- If a well-fitted mask can not be worn or you choose not to wear a mask, a full 10 day isolation must be completed.
